Internationally award-winning duo, Ziggy and Miles Johnston have been playing guitar together since they first started their study of the instrument at age 4. From an early age Miles and Ziggy entered many Guitar Eisteddfods in both solo and duet categories, earning themselves many prizes. As a duet, they were awarded 3rd place in the 2017 Guitar Foundation of America International Ensemble Artist Competition. Miles has won first place in the 2015 Melbourne Recital Centre Bach Competition and second place in the 2016 Adelaide International Guitar Festival Competition while Ziggy received second place in the 2015 and 2016 Melbourne Recital Centre Romantics Competition.
