Canyon celebrate Woodstock 50th anniversary.

It's August 1969 and Woodstock Music Festival present the newly formed Crosby, Stills, Nash & Young debut concert. Fifty years later 4 piece, Melbourne based band "Canyon" mark the Woodstock 50th anniversary with a sold out concert at Melbourne's Caravan Club. In keeping with the Woodstock vibe, they will continue to share the love by undertaking a tour throughout regional Victorian towns, including this GAMC performance at Tyers Hall.

Canyon's line-up is singer, songwriter and guitarist Peter Chapman, singer, co-song writer & percussionist Louise Dempsey, Bruce Packard on vocals, bass and mandolin and Josh Bennett on vocals and multiple guitars.



Canyon's tour will feature tastefully arranged and impressive acoustic versions of many of Crosby, Stills, Nash & Young's greatest songs, including some of those first heard by the world 50 years ago at Woodstock that also inspired and became a major influence on the distinctive sound of Canyon's original compositions about deserts, forests, raging water, open highways and broken hearts. Their concert also features many other great songs from the 'Laurel Canyon, Westcoast' tradition of the 60's and 70's such as America, Jackson Browne, Linda Ronstadt, The Band, Little Feat, Seals & Crofts, Emmy Lou Harris, and Joni Mitchell. "As a harmony group we know that vocal arrangements are a time-consuming labour of love and Crosby Stills Nash & Young set the blueprint. Their songs have stood the test of time and their influence is omni-present. Canyon looks forward to celebrating their milestone Woodstock anniversary and paying our respects to a band that were politically fierce and musically even better," said Peter Chapman.

Canyon invite you to set the scene at the show by embracing your inner hippie and reaching into the depths of your wardrobe and dressina in your most colourful and peace lovina, flower power outfit. There will be a prize for the best dressed.
