Procedures for Emergency Warnings

In the event that a "Watch and Act" Warning or an Emergency Warning is listed for Tyers on a day when GAMC is hosting an event (or for other locations where GAMC may be hosting an event), the club event will be cancelled for that day. In such circumstances, we will endeavour to advise members via email, but recommend that you tune into local ABC radio and/or <https://emergency.vic.gov.au> for warning updates before leaving home.

Clearly things are still a tad uncertain during the pandemic, and a number of Covid safe regulations have been put in place, so:

- we're only planning one event ahead at a time with a focus at this stage for jam sessions, blackboard concerts and local acts
- ideally (especially during the warmer weather) we can have outside options, so the venues have been chosen accordingly
- "trybooking" is/will be set up for each event to ensure that we aren't overbooking (so if you don't pre-register on trybooking, or otherwise contact Barb, then there is a chance that you'll miss out if the venue fills up)
- A QR code has also been set up to scan on arrival. Alternatively, your details can simply be given to a committee member and these records will be kept for 30 days.
- The format has changed since supper is off the agenda at this stage 😞. However, tea and coffee may still be provided, depending on the venue...but please bring your own cup.
