Picture four friends jamming around a campfire, in the middle of nowhere, on New Years Eve. This is where it all began for Tinman - a road trip, a cigar box guitar and a little bit of magic as they found themselves making the kind of music they'd always loved. Songs you could get lost in.

From living rooms to festivals, rhythm and harmony pour from the stage. While folk, gospel, and blues-inspired melodies imbue the air with warmth and comfort, an earthy sound, accentuated by an array of enchanting instruments completes the sensory experience.

Over the course of a live show you may suddenly feel the need to sing, even if you don't know the words. And sometimes you may just want to watch the melodies disappear into the cool night air. The band recorded their debut EP in 2018, in a beach house along the rugged Victorian Surf Coast. Since then, the four have travelled far and wide and graced radio waves across Australia.

Tinman are a dream combination who come together to create an electric live performance. Come alongside these story-tellers and magic weavers and be transported for a while.

GAMC CAMP at Inverloch – 10 Grandview Grove Fri 14th July to Sun 16th July '23

The aim of the GAMC camp is to allow people to join in ad hoc music sessions with a variety of instruments in a relaxed setting. The idea of having it over a weekend is to extend the time available for this and to enable people to mingle in several different ways, and get to know one another better. Not everyone has the whole weekend free so coming just for one day/evening or just the day is also an option which may suit some people. The only scheduled item for the weekend is usually Saturday evening tea which we like to have together at about 6:30pm (This leaves us good time to clean up the kitchen and get back into the music !)

The venue has changed and we will be at 10 Grandview Grove in Inverloch. There is a large kitchen and lounge space for music. There is limited inside accommodation but room for tents or vans outside. There is a limit of 30 people for the weekend for meal times. If you wish to stay elsewhere in Inverloch, there are many options.

What to bring: Sleeping gear, towels, instruments, BYO breakfast and lunch food and drink and something to share for Sat night dinner. Please consider how you are going to take home your recycling.
