Wendy plays the Paraguayan harp, enjoying its versatility, enabling her to play a wide range of musical genres. HarmoniUs draws its repertoire from traditional Celtic, British and South American music as well as from contemporary composers, especially Australian and Canadian.

We have been very keen for some years to have Nathan perform at GAMC, and finally we have managed to lock him in for this date around his schedule of other musical and work commitments. He is an amazingly talented pianist who can perform works across a wide genre of musical styles.

Nathan is an experienced choral, classroom, and piano teacher, having worked across a variety of educational settings over the last decade. Since 2015, Nathan has primarily worked as a classroom music teacher in Traralgon, currently serving as the Head of Performing Arts -Events at St Paul's Anglican Grammar School, in addition to his role as Musical Director for the West Gippsland Chorale.

After obtaining his Bachelor of Music (Piano) from the University of Melbourne Conservatorium of Music under the tutelage of Dr Mark McGee, Nathan qualified with a Master of Teaching (Secondary) degree from The University of Melbourne Graduate School of Education.

Prior to classroom music teaching, Nathan was the Musical Director for the Apollo Health Music Society Choir at The University of Melbourne, Parkville Campus. This choir was a mixed voice, un-auditioned SATB choir to suit various ability levels. In this position he directed the choir through two major concerts a year, as well as minor performances at nursing homes and hospitals. Since then, he has been heavily involved in community musical theatre as musical director, vocal coach and rehearsal pianist for Latrobe Theatre Company. As a part of his role at St Paul's Anglican Grammar School, Nathan directs a variety of ensembles at the Traralgon campus.

Nathan currently serves as Vice-President of the Association of Music Educators VIC Inc. (aMuse). In previous years, he has served as Secretary for the Australian National Choral Association (ANCA) Vic-Tas branch, General Committee Member for Australian Choral Conductor Education and Training Inc (ACCET) and General Committee Member for Latrobe Theatre Company.
