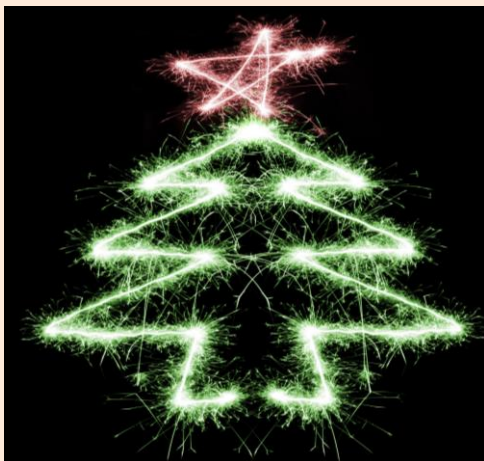
Procedures for Emergency Warnings
