RILEY CATHERALL

Riley Catherall is a Melbourne-based Singer-Songwriter whose graceful trajectory into the Australian Alt-Country Music world has not gone unnoticed. Riley has built a credible status as a one of the country's most promising songwriters through his poetic sincerity and alluring live shows.

Riley released his debut full-length album in late 2021: "When I Go" is an amalgamation of songs about leaving, losing love, and finding somewhere to settle down. National praise came in spades for singles "Mother Please", "Vacant Lot" and "Leave Me Out To Dry" - all receiving extensive streams, national airplay and an addition into ABC National's high rotation in November 2019.

Catherall's writing has also attracted international attention with radio play across Europe and the UK. After appearing at the Maverick Americana Festival in Suffolk UK, he was listed as a festival favourite alongside Lachlan Bryan and The Wildes and Hannah Aldridge. Those with a keen eye at such festivals will notice Riley on stage playing guitar for the likes of those mentioned above, as well as having accompanied and collaborated with Kasey Chambers, Charm Of Finches, Alan Fletcher, Imogen Clark and Loretta Miller (Clairy Browne & the Bangin' Rackettes).

2023 saw Riley supporting Australian icons The Whitlams, Taxiride and Ella Hooper....not to mention his GAMC performance with Michael Waugh!

"The Light, The Beautiful Liar" is Riley Catherall's second full-length record, released in mid 2024. Singles "Bark At The Moon" and "Coming Down, Coming Over" flagship this collection of songs about the kind of love that desperately tries to endure the unwelcoming stark light of the morning. A tour of the UK and Scandinavia provided those who attended an insight into the workings of a prolific songwriter in the sophomore stage of his career.

GAMC Inverloch CAMP – 10 Grandview Grove Fri 14th - Sun 16th March 2025

The aim of the GAMC camp is to allow people to join in ad hoc music sessions with a variety of instruments in a relaxed setting. The idea of having it over a weekend is to extend the time available for this and to enable people to mingle in several different ways, and get to know one another better. Not everyone has the whole weekend free so coming just for one day/evening or just the day is also an option which may suit some people. The only scheduled item for the weekend is usually Saturday evening tea which we like to have together at about 6:30pm (This leaves us good time to clean up the kitchen and get back into the music!)

As was the case with our last few camps, the venue will be at 10 Grandview Grove Inverloch. There is a large kitchen and lounge space for music. There is limited inside accommodation. but room for tents or vans outside. There is a limit of 30 people for the weekend for meal times. If you wish to stay elsewhere in Inverloch, there are many options.

What to bring: Sleeping gear, towels, instruments, BYO breakfast and lunch food and drink and something to share for Sat night dinner. (You might also want to throw in swimming gear as the beach is nearby or your bicycle as there also are great paths for riding). Please consider how you are going to take home recycling.
