Smiley-Doherty are a South Gippsland folk-rock band built around the songwriting, harmonies and lived-in musical chemistry of Kate Smiley and Pete Doherty.

Blending original songs with roots, country, folk and blues influences, the band moves between intimate storytelling and full-bodied, groove-driven arrangements led by soaring electric guitar, rich harmonies and dynamic live interplay.

Their performances balance warmth and musicianship with the atmosphere of a genuine gathering – songs shaped as much by regional life, long roads, kitchens, heartbreak and humour as by traditional genre boundaries.

With a sound that can shift from tender acoustic moments to expansive folk-rock energy, Smiley-Doherty create live shows that feel both deeply personal and joyfully communal.
